




A Cup of Cold Water: The Compassion of Nurse Edith Cavell (Chosen Daughters Series)

She was subsequently court-marshaled, found guilty of treason and sentenced to death. Despite international pressure for mercy, at the age of 49 years she was shot by a German firing squad. She is well known for her statement that patriotism is not enough.
