Excerpt from Care and Management of Orchards Bulletin No. 12 dealt principally with the preliminary work in starting commercial orchards, and I now propose to deal with the care and management of orchards after they are fairly under way. Before proceeding further, I will again refer to an unaccountable error which occurred on page 3 of Bulletin 12, where, in advising the selection of a site, I am made to say that western and southern exposures are not adapted for orchards; this should read eastern and southern. And further on a north-eastern exposure is recommended; this should read a north-western exposure. The context shows the intention, but the errors are nevertheless probably very perplexing. Cultivation. Possibly the most potent factor in the success of an orchard is the proper cultivation of the soil, keeping it free of weeds and plant growth generally, and by this means having the surface in a perfect state of tilth and thus keeping the trees healthy and strong, so that they are better able to withstand the attacks of diseases and insect...
